

## INTERVIEW SUMMARY

### California Interscholastic Federation

Report of efforts on June 26, 2007, to interview Eleimanu Seumaala. On this day, Scott Donald, the legal counsel for the San Joaquin section of the CIF, and the writer visited the home where it was reported that Seumaala lived. This house is located above a grocery store. Signs outside the store indicated that this location was also the site of Eleimanu, Inc. and Eleimanu Travel Agency, and listed the following numbers: [REDACTED]; [REDACTED]; and [REDACTED]6.

The writer and Donald walked up the stairs to the living quarters and asked a gentleman if Eleimanu was home. Eleimanu came to the door. Donald and the writer identified themselves as from the CIF. Eleimanu immediately responded that she was not obligated to talk with us and that she was also taking care of her sick husband. The writer asked if she would talk with them on the next day, and she stated that she would not. The writer asked if she would talk in the future, and she stated that she would not. She indicated that she was not available today, tomorrow, or in the future. At that point, the writer and Donald thanked her and left the property.
