Joe,

Student must live in their attendance area for one year with their parents. Otherwise, parents could move and stay for one month, two months and then move back and student is eligible where they moved. This type of movement is not acceptable. Student is eligible at the school where his parents have moved and the student can move back with them. The caregiver document and the age issue is not a factor in this decision. The student would have to file hardship papers and go through the CIF process for eligibility. Thanks,
