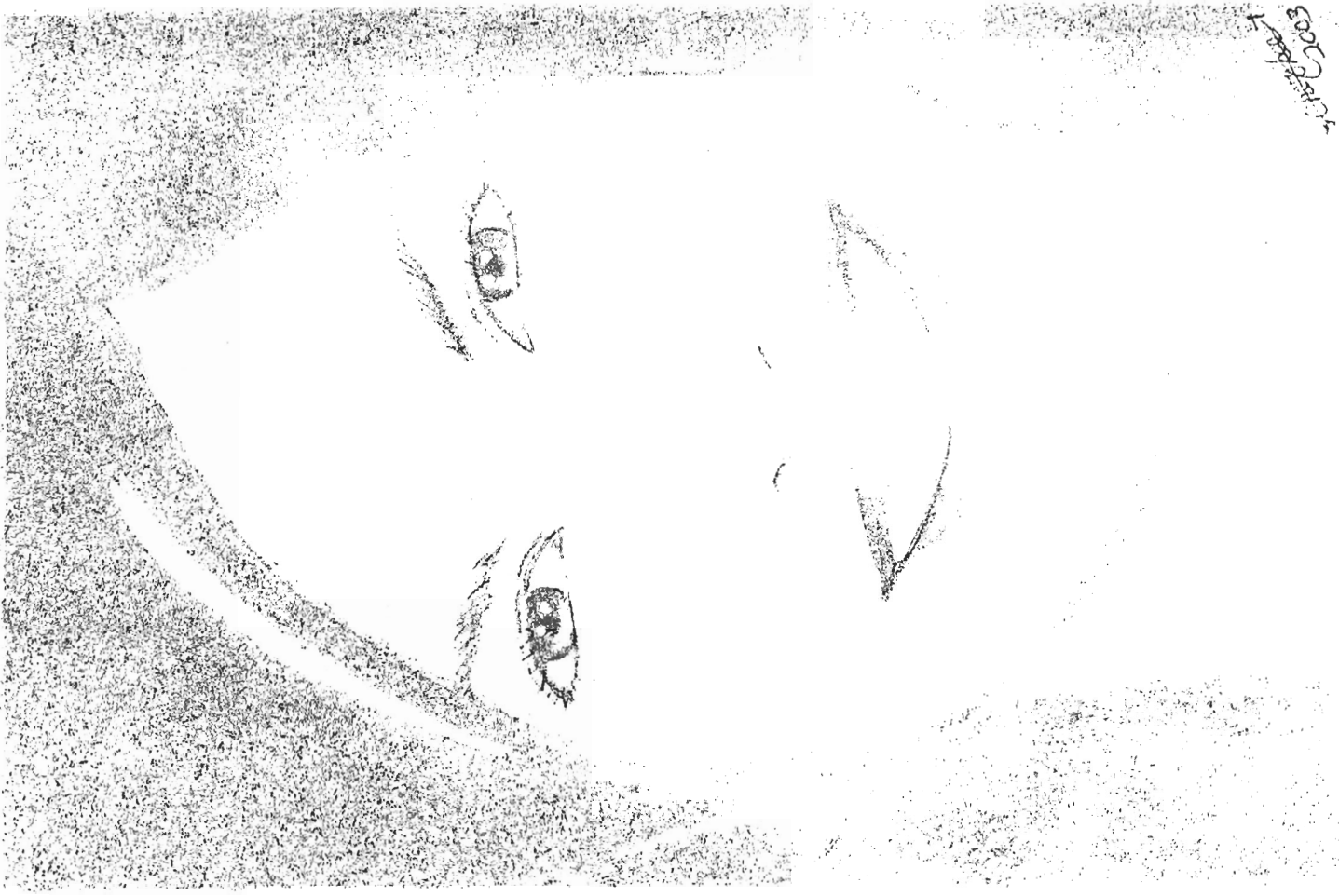
**SUBJECT: Release of Recorded Song Dedicated to Laci Petersen

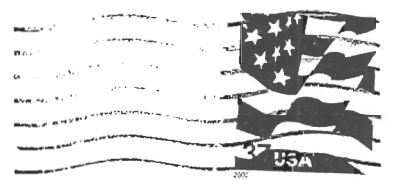
