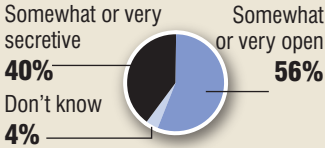


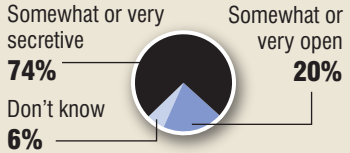
IS THE GOVERNMENT SECRETIVE?

How Americans feel about government secrecy, spying on the public and political candidates' positions on open government:

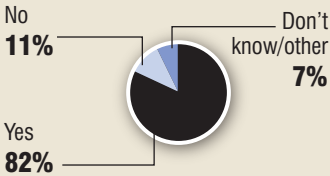
Is your local government open or secretive?



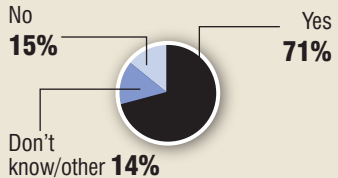
Is the federal government open or secretive?



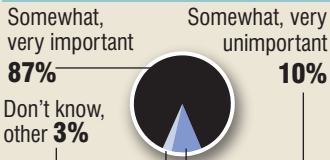
Do you think the public should be allowed to see with whom lawmakers meet?



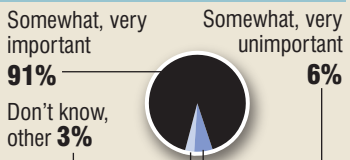
Should a city police department allow the public to see incident reports about specific crimes in local neighborhoods?
