

# DELAYED DEVELOPMENT

A proposed 479-lot development south of Escalon that would have included a \$6.5-million, 31-acre regional park has been put on hold by the city and Stockton-based Frontiers Community Builders. The Northern San Joaquin Valley's housing collapse and sewer capacity issues combined to stall the project, officials said. It would have added about 2,000 people to a city that now has 7,100 residents.
