Division I--DRL

- Oak Ridge and Ponderosa have been placed in this league because of the disparity in size of schools in the current SVC. They have been placed in this league to keep their travel at a minimum.
- Monterey Trail has been moved to the DVC to balance the two Delta Leagues.
- Florin has been moved to Division II Metro for competitive equity.

Division I--DVC

- Grant has been moved because of the disparity in competition in football in the Metro.
- Monterey Trail has been added to balance the two Delta Leagues.
- Valley has been moved to the Metro for competitive equity.

- Rodriguez has been added because they have increased in school size and are no longer a fit in SCAC.

Division II--CVC

- This is a new grouping of schools that we are calling the CVC.
- This is necessary because of the new schools being added in the Sacramento area.
- We have split the six San Juan schools in the CAL into two leagues and combined them with other schools to create this new league.
- The three San Juan schools are: Bella Vista, Casa Roble and Del Campo.

Division II--CVC cont.

- The three other schools are: Christian Brothers, Oakmont and Rio Linda.
- This grouping of six schools will keep travel at a minimum.

- Grant has been moved to Division I.
- Kennedy is now in the Metro for all sports.
- Florin and Valley have been added to make an eight-team league.
- These moves were made to create better competitive equity in all sports.
