

LOST TO FORECLOSURE

Since September 2006, nearly 48,000 homes with a combined loan value of nearly \$18 billion have been lost to foreclosure in Stanislaus, San Joaquin and Merced counties, according to statistics gathered by ForeclosureRadar.com.
