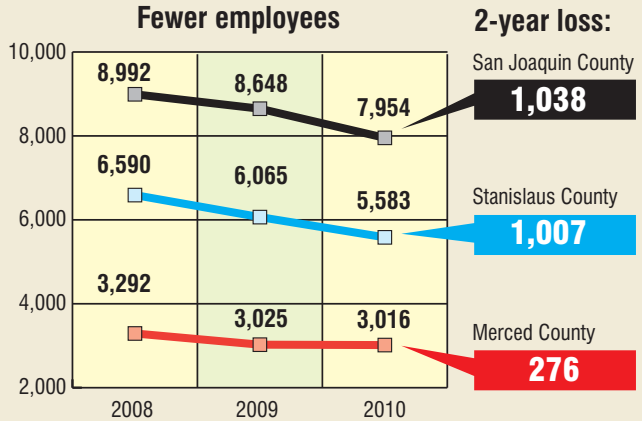


REGIONAL GOVERNMENT CUTS

County and municipal governments in Stanislaus, San Joaquin and Merced counties employed 2,321 fewer workers in 2010 than they did in 2008, going from a high of 18,874 full-time jobs to 16,555 full-time jobs.
