

Modesto Bee Electronic Edition Feature Sheet

Click on E-edition Link or Sign In to E-edition from NIE site

Electronic Edition Newspaper Opens to Landing Page on left side of page and front page of newspaper on right side of page. You are within the “Contents” tab.



Click on “What’s Inside” and then click on “Table of Contents” to open TOC



Single click any section to provide additional detail on the stories within that section and to open the page of the paper within that section



Click on “full text” to open complete article.

Click on “Page Thumbnails” to view graphic of each page. Can click on individual page thumbnail to be taken to that page.



“Featured Pages” can be designated as custom viewed pages but default is front page and back page.

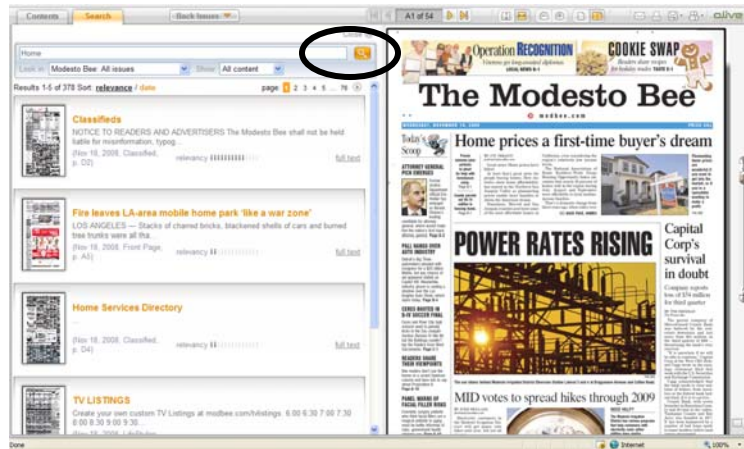
“Help” assists with basic Electronic edition functionality

Go up and click on “Search” tab.



You are now within the “Search” function of the Electronic Edition. From here you can enter a search term in the window and select a publication (Modesto Bee) and what to present (show), such as articles, ads, photos or all. You can search from within the current edition or through those past editions that are available (usually 7 days)

Enter your search term, then hit the orange shaded box with the magnifying glass to launch your search.



You are now presented with a hit list of pages that covers your search term. You can select the page to go to that page or hit “full text” to just launch the article/ad/photo.

Click on the “Back Issues” tab

This section allows you to view past issues of the Modesto Bee. Just click on one of the thumbnails to open that issue. From within the issue you have all of the same functionality as that which is available in the current issue.



Hit "Close" to shut down the left hand side of the screen and go to full newspaper view mode.



We will now be dealing with the primary newspaper reading functionality. Click on the top right corner of the newspaper page to turn the page. You can also go to the page arrow or page number box to advance the pages.



You can also size the paper to fit in the available screen/window based on your preference. You can fit to height, fit to width or display one page at a time or two pages at a time, as follows:



You can also zoom in and zoom out to view the page. Click once to zoom into a full reading mode and zoom out to return to default zoom mode. Double click on an article to open that article in it's own text box.



From there, you can read article, display in text mode or newspaper mode (text mode allows you to cut and paste text into external applications), print the article, e-mail the article, bookmark the article, post article in social networking sites.
